SALISH RAVEN DEPARTS CANARY ISLANDS

VICTORIA – Salish Raven, the third of three new Salish Class vessels, stopped in Santa Cruz, Canary Islands on May 7 for refuelling and provisioning, and is now en route across the Atlantic Ocean to Panama. The vessel is expected to arrive in Panama in approximately two weeks, depending on weather.

The voyage is going well according to the ship's crew. BC Ferries looks forward to welcoming Salish Raven home to B.C. next month.

BC Ferries will take final acceptance and ownership of Salish Raven upon final inspection once the vessel arrives in B.C. Remontowa Shipbuilding S.A. is responsible to deliver the ship to B.C. and has contracted with a professional international ship delivery specialist. Some of BC Ferries' crew members are on various legs of the voyage for training and familiarization.

Under contract to the Province of British Columbia, BC Ferries is the service provider responsible for the delivery of safe, efficient and dependable ferry service along coastal British Columbia.


